MISSION

We empower students to be enthusiastic, curious learners and kind, compassionate leaders in our community and the world.

SCHOOL

Berlin High School is a four year comprehensive high school, accredited through the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. Berlin High School provides approximately 860 students with an extensive curricular program of studies along with a wide range of co-curricular opportunities. Berlin High School also accepts students from the Open Choice Program, which enables students from the capital city of Hartford to attend school in nearby suburban setting.

COMMUNITY

Berlin is the geographic center of Connecticut, south of Hartford. With a population of approximately 20,000, it is both a residential and industrial community. Residents of the community are employed in professional, skilled, and semi-skilled occupations. The hamlets of Kensington, Berlin, and East Berlin comprise the community. The Board of Education governs three elementary schools, one middle school, and one high school.

STAFF

Berlin High School employs 64 general education classroom teachers with an average student-teacher ratio of 13:1. Additional staff includes 3 administrators, 4 school counselors, 1 district supervisor of school counseling, 1 school psychologist, 2 social workers, 11 special educators, 2 Effective School Solutions social workers, 1 speech pathologist, 0.4 ESOL educator, 1 library/media specialist, and 1 athletic director.

GPA AND CLASS RANK

Grading is calculated by a numerical system 0-100. Transcripts report final grades in all courses taken from grades 9-12. The minimum passing grade is 60%. In consideration of the difficulty of the actual course work, an eight point differential is added to all high school courses designated honors, honor's challenge, Advanced Placement, dual enrollment, dual credit or early college. A four point differential is added to all high school courses designated as Advanced. Berlin does not report class rank.

TRANSFER CREDITS

When a student earns credits from an accredited institution other than Berlin High School, the courses are noted on the transcript as courses completed in curriculum categories (e.g. Humanities, STEM, etc.) toward the credits required for graduation. The courses will be listed on the BHS transcript as "TR Humanities, TR STEM" (etc.) and they will be given the credit value received along with a P (pass) or F (fail).

COURSE LEVELS

Courses are offered on three levels: College Preparatory; Advanced; and Honors. Additionally, Learning Center and ESOL courses are offered to students who qualify. Not all courses are offered at each level.

Advanced Courses include: American Studies, Biology, Chemistry, English 9, French IV, and Spanish IV

Honors Courses include: Algebra I, Algebra II, French V, Geometry, Multivariable Calculus, and Precalculus

UConn ECE Courses include: Discrete Math, Drawing, Introduction to Individual and Family Development, Seminar in Writing and Multimodal Composition, and Spanish V

Advanced Placement courses include: Art & Design (2D, 3D, and Drawing), Calculus AB, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Psychology, U.S. Government, and U.S. History

Advanced Placement combined with UConn ECE Courses include: Biology, Calculus BC, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics, and Statistics

SCSU EC courses include: Zoology

CCP courses include: Accounting I, Accounting II, and Computer Aided Design (CAD)


